



## DAY BY DAY ITINERARY

## DAY 1 / COLONIA DEL SACRAMENTO

On arrival to Colonia transfer to Hotel Plaza Mayor located in front of the main square. Tour of Colonia del Sacramento with lunch included at La Florida Restaurant. Accommodation at Hotel Plaza Mayor. L



## DAY 3 / FINCA NARBONA

Morning at leisure. Picnic lunch in the vineyards and late afternoon wine and cheese pairing tasting in the cellar guided by the winemaker of Finca Narbona (includes three different Narbona wines and seven choices of cheese). Accommodation at Finca Narbona Wine Lodge. B, L.



## "TANNAT" IS TO URUGUAY THE SAME AS "MALBEC" IS TO ARGENTINA.

The Tannat is a variety of grape that has grown to be more important in Uruguay than in France, where it comes from. Nowadays, the land planted with this grapevine in Uruguay is greater to the surface found in France. The country's wine heritage goes back to the first Spanish and Italian immigrants who brought the grapevine some 250 years ago. In the XVIII century the Jesuits established in the north of the Province of Colonia in Uruguay, where they continued their mission and built the national monument "La Calera de las Huerfanas" in 1741. This chapel was located inside the extensive land of an estancia where they planted fruit trees, breed cattle and produced lime. This is where Indians, slaves and priests would gather. After the Jesuits were expelled by the Spanish crown, don Juan de San Martín took the administration of the estancia and found 1500 stocks of grapevine... this is where wine was born in Uruguay... Only 2 km from where the former Jesuit vineyards used to be, we can nowadays find **Zubizarreta** winery.



## DAY 2 / COLONIA - CALERA DE LAS HUÉRFANAS -**BODEGA IRURTIA & EL LEGADO**

"After breakfast, transfer towards the area of Carmelo. The tour starts with the visit of "La Calera de las Huerfanas" Jesuit Ruins where the Uruguayan history of wine begins and where we can still see the Zubizarreta vineyards in the same location where the first vines were planted. We will then continue to the Irurita winery where we will start our tour at 11:00 in the morning; depending on the season, guests will be able to see the harvest, bottling or grape manual selection. After the tasting, we will continue our tour towards Cordano Winery where we will learn about the family legacy of this vineyard. We will then continue towards Finca Narbona Wine Lodge where guests will enjoy dinner (not included) and spend the night. Accommodation at Finca Narbona Wine Lodge. B, L (tastings).



After breakfast, private transfer (no guide) to Colonia to board the morning ferry.



## THE TRAILS OF CHEESE & WINE IN URUGUAY

Both *cheese* and *wine* were introduced in Uruguay by families of immigrants that arrived to these lands more than 250 years ago. Today, many vineyards, wineries and local cheese artisan producers open their doors to curious guests and tourists from all over the world delighted to taste these hidden Uruguayan gastronomy treasures!





DAY BY DAY ITINERARY

## DAY 1 / COLONIA - NUEVA Helvecia & Cheese Farms



During the morning, guests will be driven to the local bus station to board a regular bus to the town of "Nueva Helvecia" where a private transfer will be waiting to drive them to "La Posada de Ofelia". The peaceful atmosphere of the town, blends with the friendly inhabitants and their hospitality. The traditional cheese production is one of the most distinctive features of the place and it has become the cover letter not just of Nueva Helvecia, but of the complete Province of Colonia and so the delicious "Colonia Cheese" has been named after the area. Sweets and preserved marmalades and dairy production has led to many important industries in the area. In the afternoon, guests will enjoy a tour of the area visiting three of the local cheese farms to learn about the history and local production of artisan cheese with tasting included (We usually visit the Old Karlem Cheese farm, La Brida cheese farm dedicated to blue cheese and Maria Noel Boutique cheese farm). Accommodation at "La Posada de Ofelia".



## HIGHLIGHTS

**Uruguayan wine, the mysterious "Tannat"**: The country's wine heritage goes back to the first Spanish and Italian immigrants who brought the grapevine some 250 years ago. In 1874, a French Basque immigrant named Harriague imported grapevine cuttings of the obscure French variety called Tannat ("Tah-naht.") This red grape, usually grown only in Madiran, a small wine region in Southwestern France, produces dark, dense red wines of extremely tannic nature (the name "Tannat" is said to stem directly from "tannin"), so harsh and unyielding that they often require years of aging to become drinkable.

Tannat proved an excellent match for the soil and climate in Uruguay, and it has become the country's leading variety, as closely associated with the place as "Malbec" has become the trademark variety for Argentina.

**Uruguayan Artisan Cheese:** On the other hand, the knowledge on "Artisan Cheese" was introduced in Uruguay by immigrants of Swiss origin. After settling in the Province of Colonia, they founded what is nowadays "Colonia Suiza" and as soon as the activity of the first producers showed to be profitable, they were imitated by the nearby towns extending the artisan cheese production area to the Province of San Jose.





#### DAY 2 / NUEVA HELVECIA - MONTEVIDEO



After breakfast, transfer to the local bus station to board the regular bus to Montevideo. On arrival, guests will be met by a local driver and transferred to My Suites Boutique Hotel. After checking in, they will be driven to the lively Port to enjoy a typical "asado lunch". Afternoon walking tour of Montevideo's Old city with visit to the local museums. Accommodation at My Suites Hotel. B, L.



## DAY 3 / MONTEVIDEO

Morning at leisure. In the afternoon, guests will enjoy a tour of two different vineyards of Montevideo including tastings of Tannat wine. Accommodation at My Suites Hotel, B.




## DAY 1 / ESTANCIA Ninette, Inspiring Views of The Black River

Arrival to Estancia Ninette, a wonderful property built in the middle of a spectacular setting just in front of the Black River (which divides Uruguay from east to west) and its surrounding untouched nature. In the afternoon we will enjoy horseback riding and discover the surroundings. Dinner and accommodation at Estancia Ninette. D.

## DAY 3 / MERCEDES, A Beautiful City

We will enjoy the morning at the estancia; you will have the chance to choose between horseback riding, birding or if you like fishing, this area of the Balck Rover is famous for the fishing of the "Dorado" (one of the strongest freshwater fish and strongest predator in South American Rivers. Bright gold in color, it is considered as the king of fish in these fluvial systems.). Fishing is organized with flies and artificial lures; boats equipped with coolers and the safety equipment needed for our guests to enjoy the adventure (please note that fishing has an extra cost). After lunch, we will visit the lovely local city of Mercedes: the coastal Rambla, squares, history and the "Maua Castle" where wine and olive oil is produced givin us the chance to enjoy a tasting. We will enjoy lunch in a restaurant next to the shores of the Black River and after a small walking tour of the old city visiting the cathedral, monuments and pedestrian area; we will continue our trip to the next destination. (Please note that transfers can be provided

in private basis or using the local regular buses which are very good)

Just after breakfast, we will board our canoes and paddle down the River. We will get the chance to visit the "Austriaco" island and its two internal lagoons, habitat of many local birds and capybaras. The peaceful and lovely landscape of white sand beaches is incredible. We will paddle 5 kms (more or less 2 hours) until we reach "Barrancas Coloradas", a risk of approximately 20 meters that stands over the river and forms a beautiful beach, where we will enjoy a typical "Uruguayan asado" lunch made by one of our local hosts while we enjoy the river. We will return to the estancia in the afternoon (please note that a support boat will continuously follow us and if someone gets tired, the canoe can easily be pulled back to the estancia. Dinner and accommodation at Estancia Ninette. B, L, D.



## EXPERIENCE THE "OLD-TIME CHARMS" OF PUEBLO GARZÓN

#### 3 DAYS

A sleepy town with great chefs, delicious food and a peaceful landscape of green fields, dirt roads, olives and vineyards,..., where you can spend hours watching the horizon and soothe your soul...





A SLEEPY TOWN THAT ALMOST DISAPPEARED... There are various versions as to when Garzon was founded...around 1890, the first settlers arrived to these lands and established next to the local stream where people would make a stop when travelling towards the province of Rocha, where Governor Vicente Garzon had a "saladero" (salt-cured meat ranch). In 1920, a wheat mill was built and the town quickly grew to a population of approximately 2000 inhabitants, most of who worked in local farms and mines. The train had 4 daily services (2 of them towards Rocha and another 2 towards Montevideo) and a bus service to San Carlos plus various carriages that would transport people around the area. Carnival was celebrated with a big party; the town had a theatre and a local orchestra. Unfortunately, times of economic crisis arrived and the mill was closed, the trains ceased to arrive and most of the inhabitants had to move either to San Carlos or Rocha. Only 200 people who dedicated to rural

activities, stayed in the now quiet and sleepy town.

In 2004, the renowned Argentinean chef Francis Mallmann partnered with the Argentinean winemaker Manuel Mas, and founded the Garzon Restaurant and Hotel which brought a new "hippie chic" spirit to the area. Word began to spread about the town's old-time charms: gauchos riding on horseback along tidy gravel streets, residents greeting one another by name, and children playing in a flower-filled central plaza. Along with the arrival of travelers in search of epicurean fare came a smattering of new restaurants, boutiques and high-end establishments, including a winery, bringing new life into this quiet corner of the Uruguayan countryside...

On arrival to Garzon, transfer to Casa Ana, your "home in town", the most perfect and charming Bed & Breakfast for your "culinary getaway". Guests will have time to explore the surroundings and enjoy a beautiful candle-light dinner under the stars (summer only) as a welcome. Accommodation at Casa Ana.













## DAY 2 / COLINAS DE GARZÓN, A TALE OF VINEYARDS AND OLIVE PLANTATIONS

After breakfast, guests will be transferred to Colinas de Garzon, where the best olive oil of Uruguay is produced. For those who enjoy the taste of new experiences, spectacular views, top quality wines and olive oils, this will be a wonderful visit. You will be able to learn all the secrets of the extra virgin olive oil and explore the olive plantations and Boutique Production Plant. It is an invitation to discover the origins of this product and its elaboration process followed by an amazing tasting of the fine wines and olive oils of Colinas de Garzon, combined with selected homemade cheeses. Transfer back to Pueblo Garzon for some quality time to rest and be prepared for your evening cooking class!

Experience firsthand the good tastes of Garzon! We have designed tonight's cooking class to expose you to the best that our regional products have to offer. You will spend a lovely evening with hands-on instruction by one of our professional local chefs so that you take not only your memories home, but also some great recipes and techniques to add to your own collection.

## DAY 3 / GOODBYE

After breakfast, you will have time to relax at the Posada or enjoy a bike or horse ride (additional cost) to the chain of mountain ranges that are behind the town and that give birth to the creek of Jose Ignacio and its affluents; this area is perfect example of the local geography, small streams and waterfalls that surround the closed forests of "Coronillas", where the Wild boar, capybaras, the local "Ñandu" and armadillos can be found. Some of the birds that can be appreciated, are the "Churrinche", the "viudita", the Owl and the "Picapalos" (Transfers can be arranged to your next destination, airport or port)

## PUNTA DEL ESTE S FOOD & WINE FESTIVAL

8 DAYS

"Punta Del Este", in the southern east coast of Uruguay, is famous for its wide Atlantic beaches and glamorous parties. Some of the best chefs in the region have opened restaurants in this beach town, which is fast emerging as a foodie destination.



**One of the best foodies' festivals with a grand finale...** Punta Del Este Food & Wine Festival is held every year between October/November and is one of the best foodies' festivals in Punta Del Este. The festival brings together the best and most renowned chefs not only from Uruguay, but from other countries as well: Spain, Brazil, Argentina and USA. The festival takes place in various hotels and sites of Punta Del Este and apart from celebrating food and wine with the most delicious

and mouthwatering dishes and drinks, the festival also includes various entertainment performances including live music concerts.

#### A true heaven for even the most demanding gourmands!

Each event highlights Uruguay's local ingredients and each dish is paired with a Uruguayan wine (the country is an up-and-coming wine producer) including a "viognier" from the newly launched Bodega Garzón, which hired the Italian winemaker Alberto Antonini (an influential consultant who has worked with top wineries in Tuscany)

The festival's finale, has always been hosted by the Argentine chef Francis Mallmann in nearby Pueblo Garzón, the tiny rural town where he opened a hotel and restaurant some years ago. Mallamann's fame is built around cooking with fire and this is the perfect place to be a witness of his trademark "SEVEN FIRES" (which includes rescoldo, where he covers ingredients with hot embers, and infiernillo little hell, literally- where food is placed in cast iron boxes between two levels of fires) burning throughout the streets of Garzon.

Arrival and transfer to My Suites Hotel in Montevideo a hotel based in Uruguayar wines where you will have the chance to taste wines from different wineries. Day at leisure.

#### DAY BY DAY ITINERARY

## Day 1 / Crossing the "Eastern Biosphere Reserve" on a canoe

Whether you are in the area of Punta del Este, Jose Ignacio or Montevideo, a transfer will pick you up at your hotel and drive you towards the Garzon Lagoon, the natural limit between the provinces of Maldonado and Rocha. This unique protected natural area is part of what we call the wetlands of the "Eastern Biosphere Reserve" internationally recognized within the framework of the Man and the Biosphere (Man and the Biosphere, MAB) of UNESCO since 1976. After crossing on the charming "Balsa", will continue onto the Rocha Lagoon, a semi-freshwater lagoon of 72 km2 (28 sq mi). This lagoon, located only 25 minutes from Jose Ignacio Village, has an outlet to the sea during winter months and constitutes a bird paradise with 220 species which have been recorded like migratory waders, Flamingos, Swans, Herons and ducks among others.

A Lares guide will be waiting for us to board on a canoe adventure that will take us across this beautiful lagoon full of birds, local wildlife and native vegetation! We will be able to see various bird species, local wildlife and native vegetation and once on the other side, our bikes will be waiting for us to ride to the village of La Paloma with its beautiful lighthouse where we will make a stop to enjoy a picnic lunch. We will then continue onto Pueblo Barrancas Eco Lodge to spend a peaceful night close to the Atlantic Ocean.



## DAY 2 / RETURN

After breakfast, we can coordinate a transfer to your next destination (not included) or add some extra nights at this beautiful lodge.



#### **IMPORTANT NOTE**

- Please note that in an effort to reduce carbon dioxide emissions, we have arranged your luggage and belongings to be transfer across the lagoon on a canoe specially dedicated to this task. This will help us avoid unnecessary vehicle transfers, saving at least 170 kms of CO2 emissions. (Tourism, as other sectors too, contributes to global emissions. According to the UNWTO-UNEP study (2008) tourism contributes around 5% to global CO2 emissions and 75% of the sector's emissions are generated by transportation). If necessary, we can coordinate a transfer for your luggage but we will charge an extra 5% (equal to the 5% contribution of tourism to global CO2 emissions) to the usual cost of this which will be 100% donated to Karumbe, the local NGO working on marine life conservation. Moreover, Lares, will donate another equal 5% to the same cause.

- This tour can also start with the biking adventure from Jose Ignacio or organized as a day tour without staying at the lodge in Rocha.



## TREKKING ADVENTURE FROME VALIZAS SEASIDE TOWN TO THE VILLAGE OF CABO POLONIO

Trek across the incredible sand dunes that maintains the village of Cabo Polonio isolated from the other nearby towns



#### DAY BY DAY ITINERARY

Day 1 / The most amazing view of the Atlantic Ocean from the "Cerro Buena Vista" on top of the Sand Dunes

A Lares English-speaking local guide, will pick you up from La Paloma, La Pedrera or one of the nearby coastal towns and drive you to the coastal village of Valizas. After a short walk around the town, we will start a marvelous 4-hour trekking across the amazing shifting sand dunes of Cabo Polonio. Once on the top of the "Buena Vista Hill", you will enjoy a breathtaking view of the Atlantic Ocean before descending to the shore for a relaxing coastal hike to the small fishing village. Climb the lighthouse, watch one of the largest colonies of sea lions of South America and enjoy a delicious seafood lunch overlooking the ocean. Afternoon 4-wheel-truck drive out of the natural reserve to Posada Valizas, a small charming Posada in one of the friendliest towns in the coast! L.





The lovely village of Barra de Valizas is the perfect starting point to reach the shifting sand dunes along the Atlantic Ocean. Enjoy trekking across the dunes and along the shore, explore the flora of this special region and learn about the more than 200 species of colorful birds that guide your way to Cabo Polonio. The unique fishing village at the cape will be reached after four hours trekking. Colorfully painted houses, cozy beach restaurants and a stunning lighthouse await you as well as thousands of seals. Head to a charming small posada in the area on 4x4 Jeeps to spend the night before you head to your next adventure!

## DAY BY DAY ITINERARY

## Day 1 / The Ficus Forest, black lagoon and palm groves

A Lares guide will pick you up at La Paloma, La Pedrera or some of the nearby towns and drive you to the area of "Castillos" town. Our adventure starts at the "Trail of the Indians", entrance to "Establecimiento Don Bosco" and where we start to hike towards the "Navarro Hill", down the ravine and across the Ficus Forest to the top of "Cerro de la Virgen", from where we will appreciate the most amazing view of the massive Palm Groves of Rocha. There are numerous legends regarding the origins of the palm groves. Some 500 palm trees per hectare can be found in this Palm Grove considered the world's largest and most fascinating one. We will trek down to the shores of the "Black Lagoon" also known as "Laguna de los Difuntos" ("The Lagoon of the dead") due to its location near the indigenous graveyards or "cerritos de indios". After enjoying our pic nic lunch next to the lagoon shores, we will continue our way towards Estancia Guardia del Monte, a traditional working estancia located next to the "Castillos Lagoon". Dinner and accommodation at Guardia del Monte. L, D.




In the Province of Rocha, west of the "Black Lagoon", one of the richest ecosystems of the region can be found. Over the hills there is an important indigenous forest where the ficus forest is located and considered to be unique for its lush vegetation.



## DAY 2 / THE OMBUES FOREST & CASTILLO LAGOON

After an early breakfast, we will have the chance to visit the Ombu Forest, a very big tree with strange forms that grows in forests in this area of the wetlands. Some of the trees that stand here are more than 500 years old. The Ombú is a large evergreen tree that mostly stands solitary and has a special value in Uruguay as a source of shelter and shade. These unusual large groups of ombu trees that can be found in Rocha include ancient trees, with huge gnarled roots. Legend has it that those who visit these forests suddenly remember early childhood experiences.

After a typical "asado lunch", you will have the opportunity to enjoy horse riding or a carriage tour to the wetlands for some quality bird watching. Dinner and accommodation at Guardia del Monte. B, L, D.

## DAY BY DAY ITINERARY

## DAY 1 / CANOEING AT THE POTRERILLO NATURAL RESERVE

A Lares guide will pick you up at Punta del Diablo or La Coronilla seaside towns and drive you to the area of Santa Teresa National Park where we will be allowed onto the Potrerillo Natural Reserve with our canoes. We will have the chance to see Carpinchos (Capybaras), otters, sea lions and dozens of bird species such as the Blue Cardinal or the gorgeous Saffron-cowled Blackbird.

After a picnic lunch, we will drive to the "hippie" fishing village of Punta del Diablo where we will spend two nights at "La Viuda del Diablo", a lovely small posada located in between the sand dunes with beautiful views of the beach and ocean. L.





## DAY 2 / THE GREEN TURTLES VOLUNTEER PROJECT

After breakfast, we will drive to the town of La Coronilla from where we will start our hiking day to Cerro Verde to meet the lovely green turtles (November to March) and for those wishing to "get involved", why not help the local NGO, Karumbe, with one of the many turtle rescues they perform in the area? After enjoying a pic nic for lunch, we will continue onto the National Park of Santa Teresa to discover the historic relicts of the fortress and visit the park.





## DAY 3 / RETURN

After breakfast, transfer to the local bus station to board the regular bus to your next destination.

Transfer to the local bus station to board the regular bus to "Valentines" where someone from Estancia Los Platanos will be waiting for you. Accommodation at Estancia Los Platanos, D.







## DAY 2 / THE REAL COUNTRYSIDE LIFE OF A GAUCHO

Discover the Uruguayan countryside and enjoy life on a traditional Ranch. The captivating landscape is the perfect place to experience the authenticity of the Uruguayan countryside and to enter the world of the Gauchos. Explore the land by horse, horse cart or walks and join in the daily ranch chores and activities. After a long day of rustic life, enjoy meals homemade Uruguayan food. B, L, D.




DAY 3 / TREKKING THE "NATIONAL PARK OF QUEBRADA DE LOS CUERVOS" **PROTECED AREA** 

The next day you will experience one of the most natural landscapes of Uruguay and encounter a great variety of flora and fauna. The "Yerba Chico" stream created a canyon and formed a fascinating gorge with cliffs up to 120 meters. A narrow footpath leads you down the rocks, accompanied by the sound of the wind and the rustling of vultures flying overhead. The unevenness that comprises the scenic beauty of this place is stunning and it seems like entering different world as you make your way down to the river. After a "traditional lunch", transfer to the local bus station in Treinta y Tres to board the regular bus to Montevideo. B, L.



## DISCOVER THE UNEXPLORED VALLEYS, GORGES, GOLD MINES AND VINEYARDS OF NORTHERN URUGUAY



We will trek the "Lunarejo Valley Regional Park" (a natural protected area of 30,000 hectares with great biodiversity including deep gorges, numerous streams, 14 species of native mammals, more than 536 different animals and incredible almost unexplored landscape), visit one of the best vineyards in Uruguay and explore the gold mines of Minas de Corrales.





Arrival to Rivera city and transfer to Carrau winery and vineyards located in Cerro Chapeu, a lovely area with wonderful landscape located only 10kms from the city of Rivera (just on the border with the Brazilian city of Livramento). The route to the estancia will take us along a panoramic route over the Santana Hills which separates Uruguay from Brazil. On arrival, we will visit the vineyards located 300 mts over sea level (the highest ones in the country) where the best and most awarded Carrau wines come from. We will enjoy a premium tasting of their wines and learn about the Amat wine, one of the best Uruguayan Tannats. Dinner and accommodation at Carrau Winery in Cerro Chapeu. D.





# DAY 2 / THE LUNAREJO VALLEY, ONE THE LARGEST PROTECTED & UNEXPLORED AREAS

Just after breakfast, a local guide will drive you to the Lunarejo Valley, a national protected area where we will discover several trails. We will trek down to the Valley and across the great gorge towards the Lunarejo stream, where we will enjoy a typical "criollo lunch". During the afternoon, we will start trekking up the "Boqueron Hill" until we reach the top from where we will be able to enjoy an incredible 360 panoramic view of the whole Valley.

After a full day of incredible trekking, we will return to the wine lodge. Dinner and accommodation at Carrau Winery in Cerro Chapeu. B, L, D.

Please note we have different trail levels that can be adjusted to clients' needs and interests. A full trekking program of 3 or more days can also be organized in the area.

## CANOE JOURNEY ALONG THE QUEGUAY RIVER

The Indians who inhabited these lands gave the river its actual name; in the local Guarani language, "Queguay" means "place where dreams converge" and the area where our journey takes place is, in fact, where the "Queguay Grande" and "Queguay Chico" rivers converge.

With some 300 km of course, the "Queguay" River is one of the only ones that remain untouched and part of the area denominated "Montes del Queguay" which is already in the National Protected Areas System. Nature lovers prefer it for its rich biodiversity, and because its course is the largest continuous area of native forest to be found in Uruguay!

#### DAY BY DAY ITINERARY

Day 1 / Guichón, a small quiet town where the adventure starts



Arrival to the small town of Guichon. where we will meet tour local guides who will drive us to the "Queguay River". The canoes are waiting for us to start the adventure! We will soon discover it is a stream with cliffs on both sides, virtually no sandy shores, with several curves and a unique and exuberant native forest surrounding it. Very tall trees bend over the river and in some areas even block the water course making it difficult but more adventurous for the journey. During the late afternoon and after an exhausting paddling day, we will find a place to camp. The typical "asado" will be cooked and organized by the guides together with a big fire, locally called "fogón", and good tannat wine to celebrate the first expedition day. L, D.

#### DAY 2 / Canoe adventure in the middle of nature

After breakfast, we will continue our journey along the river and as we move along, the challenge increases: the river sometimes narrows and winding curves appear increasing speed and making it more demanding to maneuver quickly and efficiently. After a morning full of fun and adventure, we stop for a picnic lunch while appreciating the beauty of the surrounding nature and the crystal clear water that can even be drank. After some fishing (to assure our dinner), we continue until our next camping spot! B, L, D.



## DAY 3 / END OF THE JOURNEY

After breakfast, we continue the last portion of our canoe journey, still with no signs of civilization; we can only hear the birds singing and the river flowing. Canoeing is an experience in which you are in constant contact with nature; the canoe glides over water at an adequate speed to enjoy the river vegetation. And even though at times, adrenaline increases as there are several rapids where the water flows more strongly making you feel the adventure, everything is under control with the company of our experienced local guides. After arriving to our destination, you will be transferred back to the town of Guichon to board the local bus to your next destination. B, L.

## DAY 1 / COLONIA DEL SACRAMENTO

Arrival to "Colonia Del Sacramento" and transfer to Hotel Charco (or similar) located in the Old town of the City. Walking city tour along the cobbled streets of the old town of "Colonia Del Sacramento"; visit to the old buildings, old forts and Spanish and Portuguese Museums and the most important tourist spots of this Old Portuguese City form the XVII century that has been declared Patrimony of Mankind by the UNESCO. Afternoon visit to the winery "Los Cerros de San Juan" with tasting. You will be able to taste the Tannat, Uruguay's signature wine (Tannat is to Uruguay what Malbec is to Argentina). The Tannat grapes originated from southwestern France and brought to Uruguay almost 250 years ago by a French Basque immigrant and the varieties of Tannats are characterized by their softer tannins when compared with the "old vines" from France.





## Day 3 / Winery & Estancia Charabon

Morning pick up for a short panoramic city tour of the rest of the city and visit of one winery in the region of Montevideo. Afterwards, private transfer to Estancia Charabon, where you will enjoy the last hours of the day – relax by the swimming pool with a glass of wine or why not enjoy a ride through the rolling plains! Dinner at the Estancia. B, L, D




## Day 2 / Montevideo

Afternoon transfer to close by Pueblo Garzon, a small, picturesque village just 30 minutes from Jose Ignacio, where time seems to have stood still: buy your fuel in a petrol canister and stroll around the central square, where everyone knows everyone and gathers for a chat. Afternoon at leisure in Pueblo Garzon, where you will spend the night in one of the small, charming posadas.



## DAY 8 / RETURN

After breakfast, private transfer to Punta del Este airport, Montevideo airport or port.

## DAY 6 / CHEESE & WINE IN PUNTA DEL ESTE REGION

Today you will get to know "Punta del Este Gourmet". Visit the Altos de la Ballena winery, one of the newest wineries of Uruguay and one of the few in the area of Punta del Este. After a roch wine tasting, we continue on to Nonno Antonio artisan cheese farm, where you can observe the cheese production and enjoy the homemade cheeses during a tasting. Following a drive all along Punta del Este's coastline, you will be transferred to Jose Ignacio, where you will spend the night at Posada del Faro (or similar). F



## Day 7 / Jose Ignacio

We wake up in Guardia Del Monte, a traditional estancia with outstanding landscape beauty and important ecosystems containing a great variety of birds and native scrublands. We will enjoy some quality birdwatching along the large area of marshlands and wetlands both of which are teeming with bird life (more than 400 species in this area), otters, coypus and capybaras. We will be able to spot the graceful black-necked swan (largest populations in the world found here), the rare white goose, the pink flamingo (a species of flamingo with very bright pink pigment and quite common in Uruguay) and many ducks and other birds such as the largest bird in South America - the 'ostrich-like' "ñandú" (American rhea). After a typical "asado lunch" we will enjoy some horseback riding to explore the estancia surroundings. Dinner and accommodation at Guardia del Monte (Please note that depending on the season, we might stay at Guardia del Monte or Charabon Estancia and the available activities will be adapted to the area). #### Day 5 / Trekking From Valizas to Cabo Polonio, Incredible Sand Dunes and Sea Lions



After breakfast, transfer to small village Barra de Valizas, where a local guide will meet us to start an unforgettable tour to "Cabo Polonio" Village. After a short walk around the town, we will start the trekking along the coastline that will take us towards the incredible shifting sand dunes. We will trek up the "Buena Vista Hill" from where a fantastic view of the ocean can be appreciated, to continue down towards Cabo Polonio (4 hours trek). Self-drive to Finca Piedra Farm located in the region of San José (80 min. drive) where guests will be expected with a delicious lunch and will spend a first day in the Uruguayan countryside. The Estancia invites to hike, discover the own vineyards, take a bike ride across the fields, relax at the pool or enjoy an afternoon riding. Dinner and accommodation at Estancia Finca Piedra. ## DAY 5 / QUEBRADA DE LOS CUERVOS NATIONAL PARK



After a delicious seafood lunch at a local seaside restaurant, we will visit the light house and sea lions reserve. Afternoon 4x4 truck- drive towards the main entrance of Cabo Polonio where a private transfer will drive guests back to Valizas to pick up their car. Drive back to Estancia Guardia del Monte for dinner and accommodation. B, L, D.

## THE PAINTED BIRDS TOUR 7 NIGHTS, 8 DAYS

"Uruguay" means "River of the painted birds" in the traditional Guaraní local language; this tour will take you to traditional estancias, the biosphere reserve of the eastern wetlands and the oceanic coast!



#### DAY 1 / MONTEVIDEO - TOUR OF THE CAPITAL CITY & PORT MARKET



Today is set aside to relax and explore the coastal city of Montevideo. Guests are met at the Carrasco International Airport and driven along the wonderful coastline called "Rambla" to the downtown hotel. After Check in, your guide will help you discover the charming and quiet city of Montevideo, its museums, street markets, nice restaurants and friendly people. We will enjoy lunch at the lively Port Market before returning to the hotel located in downtown Montevideo. L

### Day 2 / 18 TH CENTURY Fortin de San Miguel

After breakfast we will be driven to the Brazilian border and into Rocha, arguably the most beautiful province in Uruguay with pristine beaches, emerald shores and a great network of lagoons. We will visit 'Chuy', a very curious town straddling the border where guests can step into Brazil and hear the locals speak a strange language made of a mix of Spanish and Portuguese. As we arrive at the hotel, built in the same stone as the nearby Portuguese fortress, we can admire the views out across an enormous stretch of fresh water - one of the largest fresh water reserves of South America, the "Merín Lagoon"; we are right on the Brazilian border. After lunch we will meet the gauchos and horses to ride around the rolling hills of San Miguel enjoying a wonderful panoramic view of the area from the top of the boulder covered 'Cerro Picudo'. B, L, D.



#### DAY 3 / BARRA DEL CHUY BEACH - BRAZILIAN BORDER & A RIDE ALONG A PRISTINE BEACH



After breakfast, we will be driven to our horses (5 min. drive) where they will be waiting for us ready to start a nice 3-4 hours ride towards the coast!

After a special picnic lunch, riders may have a pleasant "siesta" discovering that gauchos' saddles are so comfortable to ride as to sleep! In the afternoon, we will enjoy a fast-pace ride along the wonderful, isolated ocean beach of Barra Chuy'. Visitors seldom reach this beach so we can enjoy a long, exhilarating canter with no signs of habitation as we ride across the pure white sands alongside the Atlantic Ocean. We arrive 22km (12 miles) further south to "La Coronilla" and stay at small beachside hotel. B, L, D.

## DAY 4 / SANTA TERESA NATIONAL PARK, DOLPHINS & SHIPWRECKS

Today we will ride south alternating beaches, sand dunes, pine forests and coastal hills where we might see dolphins feeding before getting to the immense Santa Teresa National Park. The center piece of the park is a fort started in 1762 by the Portuguese to defend the edge of their territories then completed by the Spaniards who took it by assault just a year later. This was just the start of a succession of conquering, loosing and reconquering the fort; it was not until 1825 that the newly forming 'Uruguay' finally captured and held the fort. The fort is surrounded by 3000 hectares of forest containing over 2 million trees, most from other parts of the world. After a traditional picnic close to the fortress or on the beach, depending on the weather, we will continue along the coast towards the lovely town of Punta del Diablo. Afternoon drive to "Estancia El Sauce", where we will enjoy dinner and spend the night. B, L, D.



#### Day 5 / El Sauce, an authentic estancia - "mate" tea & the gaucho life



We wake up at "El Sauce", a working estancia run by its owners where we will enjoy a full day riding around the crops and the very varied vegetation of the area. The estancia, built in 1920, is very comfortable -it is not a hotel but a family house where we have been invited to stay as guests of the owners, offering us an incredible experience and a very special insight into the life of the countryside. Guests will be able to taste the 'mate' sipped hot out of a dry gourd; the gauchos and their mate are inseparable and a ceremony has developed around this drink. Overnight at this authentic working estancia. B, L, D.

## DAY 7 / CATTLE AND SHIP WORK WITH THE GAUCHOS ON THE ESTANCIA

The day starts with a lovely breakfast of homemade bread, jams and cakes, admiring the views of the countryside. A wonderful day of outstanding landscape beauty with important ecosystems and a great variety of birds and native scrublands awaits us: this area has been declared Natural Animal Reserve since 1996. We will have the opportunity to visit the forest of Ombúes; the Ombú curiously rarely grows in groups of more than 2 or 3 and the forest of Ombúes that we visit is possibly the only one in the world. Each tree has its own wonderful shape with thick, twisting roots spreading out over the ground some of which are over 500 years and have a diameter of 2 meters (6 feet). After lunch, we will ride to the nearby unique palm groves; despite a number of stories, no one knows how the 300 year old palm trees got here. B, L, D.





## DAY 6 / CABO POLONIO -SHIFTING SAND & SEA LIONS

The day starts with a drive to the ocean coast. We will meet our horses and ride into the desert! We ride through the area which has been declared a natural animal reserve and a Biosphere Natural Reserve by UNESCO. We will ride to Cabo Polonio, a charming fishing village which can only be reached by horse or four wheeled drive. The fascinating part of the area is the huge area of shifting sand dunes, as we ride through it is possible to imagine that we are right in the middle of the Sahara. After lunch at a typical restaurant on the beach we will see seals and sea lions that populate the small islands and make up one of the largest populations of seals in the world; very occasionally we spot a migrating whale. Riders can swim in one of the most beautiful beaches of the country. After this ride full of surprises and diverse scenery, we will stay at a lovely and charming working estancia in the area. B, L, D.



## DAY 8 / CATTLE AND SHIP WORK WITH THE GAUCHOS ON THE ESTANCIA



We will enjoy a full morning working alongside the gauchos and their trusty dogs as they tend to the cattle and sheep on this working ranch. The work varies depending on the time of the year, but the gauchos always welcome a bit of help checking and moving the stock or putting animals in the corrals. Sometimes a lame animal has to be caught and tended to. The wonderful, friendly gauchos with their berets, 'bombachas' (riding trousers) and with their knives tucked into their colorful belts all seem to have been born on a horse and it is a delight to be riding with them. Their dogs are very much work animals and it is an amazing sight to see four dogs working in unison moving a herd of cattle. The dogs unfortunately cannot count and that gets very tricky for us, especially with the sheep, a recount often being required! A game of armadillo jumping often inadvertently gets underway as the little armor-plated animals make a dash for their holes as the horses approach. After a quick lunch we say goodbye to the horses and head back to Montevideo - to the airport, port, the city, or to start an extension tour. B. L.

## DAY 1 / COLONIA DEL SACRAMENTO & CARMELO

(13:45) Meet at the Buquebus Ferry Boat terminal in Colonia del Sacramento for our transfer to the Charming Finca Narbona Wine Lodge, in Carmelo. During the afternoon, we will enjoy a traditional Mate tasting.

#### Meals: Dinner.

Optional bike loop around to the area of Punta Gorda, considered to be "km 0" of the River Plate (16 kms)





## DAY 2 / CARMELO

In the afternoon, cycle back to Finca Narbona where we will enjoy a cheese tasting of their specialty cheese made with crude cow's milk combined with a tannat wine tasting - leaving the best for dinner latter this evening - delicious homemade pasta, the specialty of the house!

## Day 3 / Carmelo & Colonia del Sacramento

After breakfast (9:30 am), we have a short transfer to Parque Anchorena (40 min, approximately), one of Uruguay's private national parks, for a special treat. Exclusive access to the park! From here, we'll continue on to the historical city of Colonia del Sacramento (1h30min), where we'll meet our local guide for an in-depth history of this picturesque city, then stop for another deliciously prepared lunch at La Florida restaurant. After lunch we'll visit the Portuguese museum, the Spanish museum, the Portuguese Museum of Mosaics, and the city's main church and light house. For those longing for an additional bike ride, it is possible to cycle the rest of the way to our hotel, Casa Limoneros, where we'll enjoydinner later in the evening.

The night is yours to enjoy however you see fit, and there will be a shuttle to and from the city center for those who want to head into town.

Continue the ride to Anastacio lagoon, where a fisherman boat will be waiting to take us to Garzuana for a happy hour. At the end of the Day, return to the Posada by car or continue biking. Dinner in La Huella restaurant".


